This fun lesson plan explores the book *Who Sank the Boat* by Pamela Allen. Students will read the story, participate in discussion questions, complete an activity, and take a quiz.

Who Sank the Boat Lesson Plan | Study.com

Read the book, *Who Sank the Boat*. While reading the story, encourage the children to make predictions about the different animals and whether or not they will sink the boat.; After reading the book, demonstrate how the scale/balance is used. Use the weighed objects to determine which object is the heaviest, which object is the lightest and which objects weigh the same.

The design of this lesson can be done between 2-5 days. Pick and choose what works for you. The exploration project is for young learners, they will design and test three boats and answer the question "Who sank the boat?" Kids can work in groups, pairs, or alone.
