The AHA and ERC also provide guidelines for hands-only CPR, which does not include rescue breaths. Hands-only CPR includes the following steps: Call emergency services. Interlock and position your hands on the center of the victim's chest. Press hard and fast on the victim's chest at a rate of 100-120 beats per minute until help arrives.
