FILE File Extension - What is it? How to open a FILE file?

Each file has a file extension that tells Windows what type of file that is. File extensions are usually three or four digits long, but can be longer. For example, Word documents have the .doc or .docx file extension. If you have a file named Example.docx, Windows knows it's a Word document and will open it with Microsoft Word.

How to Make Windows Show File Extensions

Right-click the file. Select the Properties option. In the Properties window, similar to what is shown below, you should see the "Type of file:" entry, which is the file type and extension. As can be seen in the example below, this file is a TXT file with a.txt file extension.

How to view a computer file extension

The easiest way to change a file's extension is to save the file as a different file type from within a software program. Changing the file extension in the file name won't change the file type, but will cause the computer to misidentify the file. In Windows and Mac OS X, file extensions are often hidden.
