Intertextuality is the relation between texts that are inflicted by means of quotations and allusion. Intertextual figures include allusion, quotation, calque, plagiarism, translation, pastiche and parody. It is a literary device that creates an 'interrelationship between texts' and generates related understanding in separate works.

Phenomenology also denies that language is self-enclosed. As Ricoeur argues, "Texts speak of possible worlds and of possible ways of orientating oneself in those worlds" (144).
