This tutorial shows how to knit two-color brioche stitch with a selvage edge over any odd number of stitches. It begins with two setup rows, one for each color. Each of the two rows in two-color brioche is worked twice, once in each color—four steps to repeat.

The half double crochet two together (also known as Hdc2tog) is a half double crochet decrease method that helps you decrease the amount of stitches from your pattern. This is a relatively simple and basic crochet stitch, so if you're a beginner, you'll definitely want to take the time to learn how to half double crochet decrease .

Not to be confused with the running man, the running stitch offers a quick way to outline a design. There are two methods you can use. The first is the sewing method: Simply weave the needle and floss through the fabric in one continuous motion to create several stitches at once, as if you were sewing a seam.

There are two major varieties of knitting: weft knitting and warp knitting. In the more common weft knitting, the wales are perpendicular to the course of the yarn. In warp knitting, the wales and courses run roughly parallel. In weft knitting, the entire fabric may be produced from a single yarn, by adding stitches to each wale in turn, moving across the fabric as in a raster scan.

3. Load the Stitches. As your top hand guides the needle up and down, don't pull the thread all the way — load two or three stitches on your needle instead. Then you can pull the thread all the way through, taking care to keep the tension even. Continue in this manner until you're done sewing that particular piece, then move onto the next ...

Fig. 1- Fold both strands of Rexlace (or S'getti) in half and to find the centers and line the centers of the Rexlace strands on a key ring or lanyard snap. Overlap one color over the other, as seen here (like colors should be parallel). To make things easier, number each strand on the cords so that you can see the pattern of each stitch.

Four Strand Round Braid (Lanyard Stitch)

Insert two straight pins vertically into the swatch, three inches apart. Count the number of stitches between the pins. Repeat with two horizontally placed straight pins for rows. If your sample has more stitches or rows than indicated in the gauge, switch to a larger hook. If your sample has fewer stitches or rows than indicated, use a smaller ...

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
